1.00. INTRODUCTION:

The year 2021-2022 was a very difficult year with the spread of Corona Virus. It was very difficult to carry on the activities as our mobility was much restricted, however we have done our best to support the people during this difficult time. We are happy that we were able to stand with people during their difficult time and provide them support. We thank Childrenshome Foundation, loving adopt parents, donor agencies, individual donors, friends and well-wishers, volunteers and likeminded people who supported our initiatives.

With the support from Childrenshome foundation we continued to support many children through the adopt parents' programme. We support the adopt children through study centres, help them to improve their quality of education, motivate them to improve their extra-curricular talents, inculcate in them good sense of morality, counsel them for getting bright future, entertain them with sports and play to keep them relax, organised camps to share mutual love and concern, provided them with good clothes, school bags, educational materials etc, encourage their active participation through gathering and celebrations and offer them gifts and sweets. But during this year it was not possible to carry on the activities in full pledged manner. We had to keep the centres closed for many months because of COVID-19 but we followed all children and supported them in all possible ways.



With the support of teachers from the study centre, we created awareness among children on COVID-19. We made them to remain at home and follow online classes. We supported their families with food packages and offered assistance to fulfil their basic needs. We also supported many other poor families with food packages. We offered special support to elderly persons and differently abled persons.

We are very proud to express our sincere gratitude to all the donor agencies especially Childrenshome Foundation, adopt parents and their families, individual donors, well-wishers,

volunteers and friends for your constant support and guidance and request your continued support in this mission so that we shall continue to extend our support to the underprivileged people who are still living around us.

DEET is carrying out the following major programmes in the target villages in which various activities are implemented for the development and growth of our target beneficiaries.

ACTIVITIES:

During this reporting year 2021-2022, DEET carried out the following welfare activities under its different programme components for its target beneficiaries and feel happy over the impact that our activities have made amidst the target beneficiaries.

A. ADOPT CHILDREN PROGRAMME:

1. Adopt Children:

With the support of Stichting Childrenshome, DEET continued to support the children in the target villages so as to make consistent changes in the academic growth of the children as well as to develop them morally responsible in all walks of life. Holistic

approach is aimed in all the activities which are executed under our Adopt Children programme. This reporting year 185 children have benefitted through our adopt children programme and among them 73 are boys and 112 are girls.

Here below give you details of adopt children as per region or cluster.

Adopt children programme aims at ensuring good education, good health and good growth and holistic development of children.



2. Study Centres:

Study centres are run in the target villages to support adopt children to improve their academic and non-academic skills. All the adopt children attend to Study programme and each Study centre is managed by a teacher in the village.

Because of COVID-19 schools were closed and children were remaining at home. Our Study centres played a vital role during this time to keep children engaged with academic activities. Since children were at home, we started the Study centres at 4 o' clock in the evening. We took all precautions measures to keep children safe. The teachers in the villages supported children to study their syllabus and clear their

doubts. Different extra-curricular activities are carried out on different days so as to ensure holistic development of the children. Different cultural and sports competitions are held at centre level, inter centre level competitions at periodic intervals conducted and prizes are distributed to the winners during Gathering day programme.



3. Value Education:

Value education is imparted to our adopt children. Two days in a week, 45minutes is spent in teaching moral and value education. Stories of great leaders, patriots, and saints are shared with the children. Children are educated on social and human values. We are happy to hear that our children behave well in the schools and at homes. They are helpful to parents, teachers and elders and they give them the due respect. Our children mingle among themselves very amicably and they don't fight with each other. Our children are also friendly to environments and have planted many trees in their schools and homes.

4. Extra-Curricular Activities:

Due attention is given for nourishing, developing and promoting our children's extra-curricular activities. Children are always encouraged to improve their inherited and acquired skills. Children are provided with football, skipping ropes, bat, carom board, chess board etc in the Study centre to develop children's sports talents. Children are also trained in athletics like running, long jump, high jump, frog race, Kabadi, Kho-Kho, etc in the available space near the Study centre. Different general knowledge books, books of great leaders, moral value books etc are displayed in the Study centre to be used by the children. Children also helped to prepare for their school level speech competitions. Periodically sports and cultural competitions are held in all the

Study centres. These kinds of training on extra-curricular activities have helped our children to participate in their school level competitions. Many of our children have won prizes in their school level sports and cultural competitions. Parents are happy when their children are learning extra-curricular activities and achieving awards and recognition.



5. Talents Day:

So as to exhibit the talents of our children, periodical centre level and inter centre level talents day is celebrated wherein our children exhibit their talents. Centre level competitions in singing, dancing, elocution, drawing etc were held. Winners were awarded with prizes. Such programme makes children more enthusiastic and makes them motivated. The parents are also motivated to support their children to improve their talents.



6. Birthday Celebration:

All the adopt children were supported to celebrate their birthdays. We support children to buy new clothes and sweets on their birthday. Children's Birthdays are commonly celebrated at Study centre and during the reporting period we have celebrated the birthdays of 36 children. The adopt children are excited to celebrate their birthday with other children in the Study centre.

7. Christmas Celebration:

A very grand Christmas Celebration was organised for all our adopt children in our office premise. All the children along with their parents and animators participated in this celebration. The Nativity of Christ was narrated and acted, prayer and worship was held before the entertainment programme. Santa Claus gave sweet to all the kids and the parents. Different cultural programmes were performed. Children were provided with good meals in the afternoon. Children were given new dresses on the day of Christmas. Children and their parents were very happy to receive the gifts and thanked the organisation. We are very grateful to Childrenshomefor the Christmas action programme.





8. Letters and Gifts from Adopt Parents:

The adopt children are very happy to receive the letters and gifts from adopt parents. The adopt children are excited to have the gifts and the gifts make them extremely happy. The adopt children are also happy to write reply letters to their adopt parents. The letters and gifts make the adopt children and their adopt parents to understand each other well. We thank all adopt parents for their loving gifts and letters.



9. Financial Assistance:

Every quarter we transfer their assistance into their accounts and they used it for their daily needs. During this year because of COVID-19 there was delay in making the transfer and in one case we have to give them cash as it was difficult for the people to access post officer service. The assistance was used to fulfil their children's educational needs, medical needs and immediate family needs. We monitor the expenditure and it is reported to Study teachers on daily basis and then the Study teachers report to us. We also check the passbook every quarter and confirm with children and families on expenditure details.



10. COVID Awareness:

With the support of teachers COVID awareness is created among the children. Children were insisted to wear masks when they had to go out and keep distances in public places. They have been advised to wash their hands frequently. They have been also asked to advice their family members as well.

11. COVID relief support:

We have supported the families of all children with food packages. We have supported all the families with food packages. We have provided two times food packages during this year. It was big help to the families.



B. LIVELIHOOD PROGRAMME:

Under Livelihood Programme we support the families of widows and deserted women for their economic empowerment. We train them on sewing skills and help them to find employment opportunity and we help them to start new income generating activity. Because of COVID-19 we had to close our training centre.

C. STUDY CENTRE FOR NON-ADOPT CHILDREN:

In order to improve the academic performance of rural children as well train them on extracurricular activities we are running three Study centre for non-adopt children in Kandai and Sathangudi villages. 120 children are attending these Study centre and it is coordinated by the teachers in the villages. Since most of their parent's illiterates or less educated they are not able to support and guide their children on education. We carry out all the activities that we carry in our adopt children Study centres. All the children are provided with school bags, note books and other educational materials for their academic excellence. All the children are provided with new clothes for Christmas. The children who attend our Study centre show improve in studies and they actively participate in extracurricular activities. This programme is supported by one of our friends. All these children's families were supported with COVID relief packages as well.



D. SUPPORT FOR HIGHER EDUCATION:

With the help of The Fund For Education and Development in Poor communities, Denmark we are helping four boys and two girls for higher education. The boys are studying diploma in electric and electronic engineering and the girl are studying degree in computer application. This is a new initiative to help rural children to pursue higher education. We are hopeful that we will be able to extend this support to more boys and girls in the coming years.



E. FAMILY SPONSORSHIP PROGRAMME:

Our friends in Germany supported 11 families with new clothes and gifts for Christmas. We organized a small event to celebrate the day with the families and it was great day for the family members. The families were also supported with vessels and household items. The families were also supported with covid relief packages. Out of the 11 families two families are supported through monthly sponsorship programme. We thank our friends Julia and Christian for this special support to the families. We are grateful for their special support to rehabilitate an orphan child is most appreciated.



F. COVID RELIEF SUPPORT TO ELDERLY PERSONS:

The poor elderly families and persons from Sathangudi, kandai and Piliurvillags are supported with food packages during the pandemic time. The support was extended to 80 such persons. Some of them received the support for second and third times.



G. COVID RELIEF SUPPORT TO DIFFERENTLY ABLED PERSONS:

Many differently abled persons were found facing difficulty during the COVID time. We identified them and provided them food packages. We supported 40 such differently abled persons.



H. CONCLUSION:

DEET as a small organization is able to help a reasonable number of families and children who deserve more our help more. We trust in God and trust in human love and affection for each other. We are happy and satisfied in what we do. We have big hearts to help all but we understand our own limitations.
